



STUD INFORMATION – TERMS & CONDITIONS 11/12 SEASON

SERVICE FEES:		Refer to individual stallion information. Advertised service fees are semen only (i.e. they are exclusive of breeding fees which will be charged by the stud/ vet where your mare is bred.)
AGISTMENT RATES:	\$7.70	per day for dry mares
	\$9.90	per day for mares and foals
	\$11.00	per day for weanlings/ yearlings
	\$11.00	per day for supplementary feeding / small paddock with shelter shed
BREEDING FEE:	\$750	The working / breeding fee covers normal breeding procedures including all ultrasound scans, inseminations, pregnancy tests etc. Other vet treatments (such as hormonal drugs, treatments, specialised procedures, injuries or illness etc) are not included in this fee and will be charged separately.
FOALING FEE:	\$275	Mares will be foaled under supervision at Pepper Tree Farm. This fee is to cover the cost of foaling alarms, night watch personnel and colostrum and IgG blood testing after foaling.
WEANING FEE:	\$275	At the time of weaning, your foal will be stabled for several days. It will also be handled prior to weaning, at weaning and over the following months to accustom it to being caught, led, tied up etc.
LIGHTS PROGRAM:	\$165	Clients can choose to place their dry mares on this program designed to promote earlier cycling -Aug/Sept.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Pepper Tree Farm is the name under which Hamerhawk Pty Ltd trades as a horse stud. All contracts regarding Pepper Tree Farm stud are with Hamerhawk Pty Ltd.
- The mare owner/ breeder undertaking the contract is hereafter referred to as "owner".
- Under HRNSW regulations we must properly identify mares as named and registered to be served. Owners are required to supply the correct details of the mare's name and brand to Pepper Tree Farm prior to serving. We also require a completed Booking Form for our contractual records.
- Mares will be drenched and vaccinated (Tetanus/ Strangles) upon arrival at Pepper Tree Farm unless prior notification has been received that the mare has had these treatments recently.
- All costs for agistment, foaling, veterinary expenses, breeding fees, service fees etc are the mare owner's responsibility
- It is the owner's responsibility and decision to insure their horse/s against all risks while at the stud or in transit and the owner acknowledges that the horse/s will be in the care of Pepper Tree Farm entirely at the owner's risk. Pepper Tree Farm will take all reasonable care with the animals in its care. However, neither Pepper Tree Farm, its members, agents or employees shall be liable for the injury, illness, disease or death suffered by any horse, from any cause whatsoever whilst in the care of the stud. We strongly recommend owners insure their valuable mares/ foals/young horses as a protection of their investment.
- Routine or emergency veterinary treatment may be requested at the discretion of the stud, with costs charged to the owner of the horse. Pepper Tree Farm will attempt to contact the owner, where possible before major surgical or costly procedures are commenced. However, the stud or its Veterinarian reserves the right to undertake any action/ treatment believed to be in the best interest of the horse.
- The service fee shall be charged and payable upon the mare having a positive final pregnancy test or at 45 days post service, if the mare has left the stud prior to a pregnancy test.
- Pepper Tree Farm reserves the right to reject any mare not in good condition physically, or not clean and fit for breeding.
- Live Foal Guarantee: If after a positive test, the mare fails to produce a live foal (stands and suckles unassisted), the owner shall be entitled to a return service to the same stallion with the same mare (or substitute by agreement) Claims regarding the failure to produce a live foal should be accompanied by a certificate from a Veterinarian and must be notified to the stud within 14 days.
- Any discounts on service fees and/or return services will be voided if the account is not paid within the trading terms which are 30 days from end of month of invoice. Costs incurred in recovering any overdue accounts will be added to the client's account.

TRANSPORTED & FROZEN SEMEN

- Semen collection days will be Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Requests for semen must be received **via fax** by the time stated on the Semen Transport Order form for shipment on those days.
- Mare owners will be responsible for the freight costs of transporting the semen to the specified location as well as the cost of the shipping container.
- All costs at the destination of the semen including scanning, insemination, other vet fees, agistment, working fees etc are the responsibility of the mare owner.
- An invoice for the service fee will be sent after 45 days if no notification of a negative pregnancy test has been received.
- Return services via semen transport are liable for a \$165 return service administration charge.
